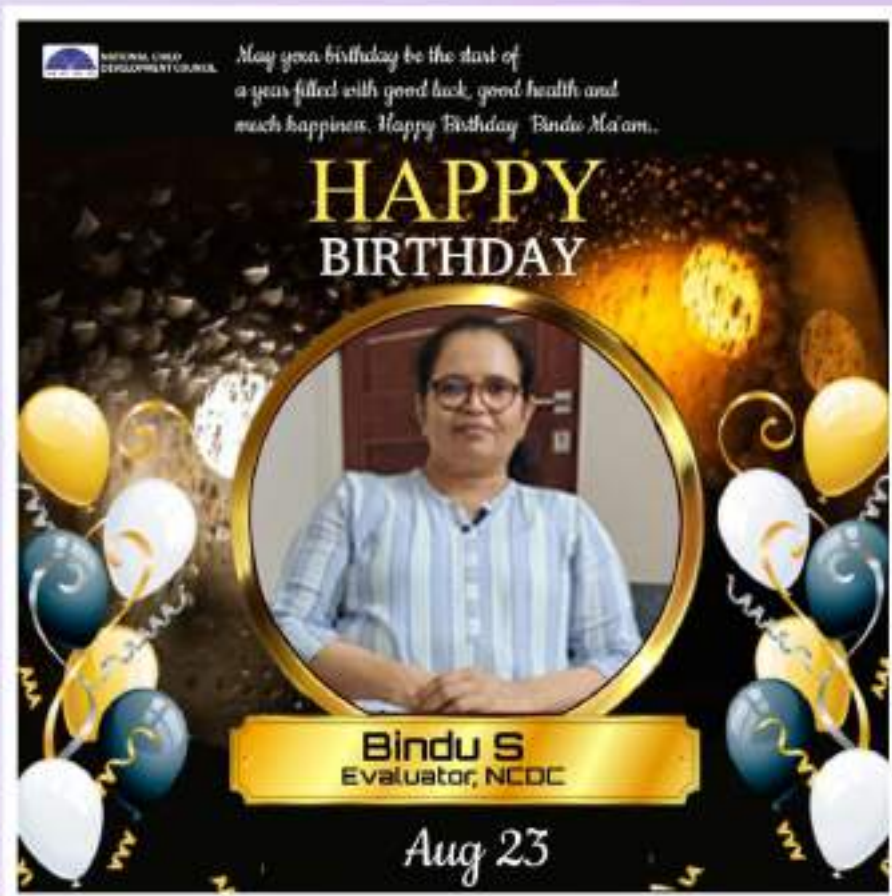

Caw, caw, caw.

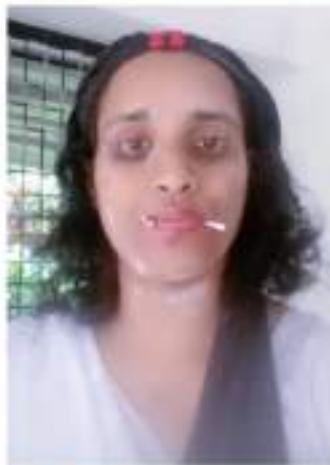
