
2023 Turkey-Syria earthquakes



On 6 February 2023, an earthquake struck southern and central Turkey, and northern and western Syria. It occurred 34 km (21 mi) west of the city of Gaziantep at 04:17 AM TRT (01:17 UTC), with a magnitude of at least Mw 7.8, and a maximum Mercalli intensity of XI (*Extreme*). An unusually strong Mw 7.7 aftershock occurred nine hours after the mainshock, centered 95 km (59 mi) to the north-northeast in Kahramanmaraş Province. There was widespread damage and tens of thousands of fatalities. The mainshock is the strongest earthquake in Turkey since the 1939 Erzincan earthquake, of the same magnitude, together with which it is the second strongest in the history of the country after the 1668 North Anatolia earthquake. The earthquake is the deadliest in Turkey since the 1268 Cilicia earthquake and also the deadliest in Syria since the 1822 Aleppo earthquake. It is one of the strongest earthquakes ever recorded in the Levant and the deadliest earthquake worldwide since the 2010 Haiti earthquake. It was felt as far as Israel, Lebanon, Cyprus, and the Black Sea coast of Turkey.

"There is no basis for the controversy related to my treatment," Mr. Chandy said in a feeble voice to the media




