Covid-19 Omicron India Updates: Vaccination for teenagers begins; India reports 33,750 fresh Covid-19 cases

Cities across the country kick-started the Covid vaccination for teenagers, aged between 15 to 18 years, on Monday. The Union Health Ministry had announced that Bharat Biotech's Covaxin will be administered to eligible children — in two doses 28 days apart.

While Delhi has set up 159 government-run centres for the age group, in Pune, 40 centres have been provided with Covaxin doses for the drive. In Mumbai, vaccination for children will be carried out at nine jumbo centres (Richardson and Crudas at Byculla, NESCO jumbo centre, NSCI at Worli, BKC jumbo centre and jumbo centres at Kanjurmarg, Malad, Mulund and Dahisar).

Meanwhile, India on Monday reported 33,750 fresh Covid-19 cases and 123 deaths. With 10,846 recoveries, the country's active caseload stood at 1,45,582.

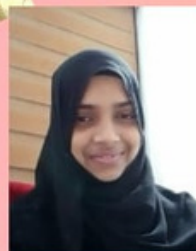
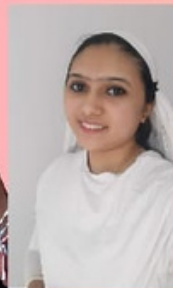
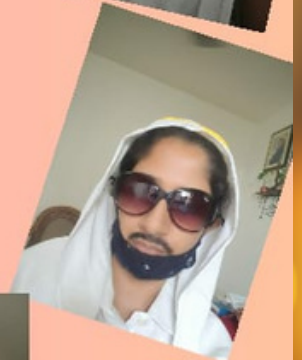

THE BASIC IDEAS AND USES OF MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCE THEORY

Multiple intelligence theory is a theory of human intelligence proposed by Howard Gardner. It suggests that intelligence is not a single entity, but rather a collection of different abilities.

There are eight types of intelligence:

- 1. Linguistic Intelligence: The ability to use words effectively.
- 2. Logical-Mathematical Intelligence: The ability to think logically and solve problems.
- 3. Spatial Intelligence: The ability to visualize and manipulate objects in space.
- 4. Musical Intelligence: The ability to create and appreciate music.
- 5. Bodily-Kinesthetic Intelligence: The ability to use one's body to solve problems.
- 6. Intrapersonal Intelligence: The ability to understand one's own emotions and feelings.
- 7. Interpersonal Intelligence: The ability to understand and relate to other people.
- 8. Naturalistic Intelligence: The ability to recognize and categorize patterns in nature.

Multiple intelligence theory has many practical applications in education. Teachers can use this theory to design lessons that appeal to different types of learners. Parents can use this theory to help their children develop their strengths.
