### Covid-19 Omicron India Updates: Vaccination for teenagers begins; India reports 33,750 fresh Covid-19 cases

Cities across the country kick-started the Covid vaccination for teenagers, aged between 15 to 18 years, on Monday. The Union Health Ministry had announced that Bharat Biotech's Covaxin will be administered to eligible children — in two doses 28 days apart.

While Delhi has set up 159 government-run centres for the age group, in Pune, 40 centres have been provided with Covaxin doses for the drive. In Mumbai, vaccination for children will be carried out at nine jumbo centres (Richardson and Crudas at Byculla, NESCO jumbo centre, NSCI at Worli, BKC jumbo centre and jumbo centres at Kanjurmarg, Malad, Mulund and Dahisar).

Meanwhile, India on Monday reported 33,750 fresh Covid-19 cases and 123 deaths. With 10,846 recoveries, the country's active caseload stood at 1,45,582.


